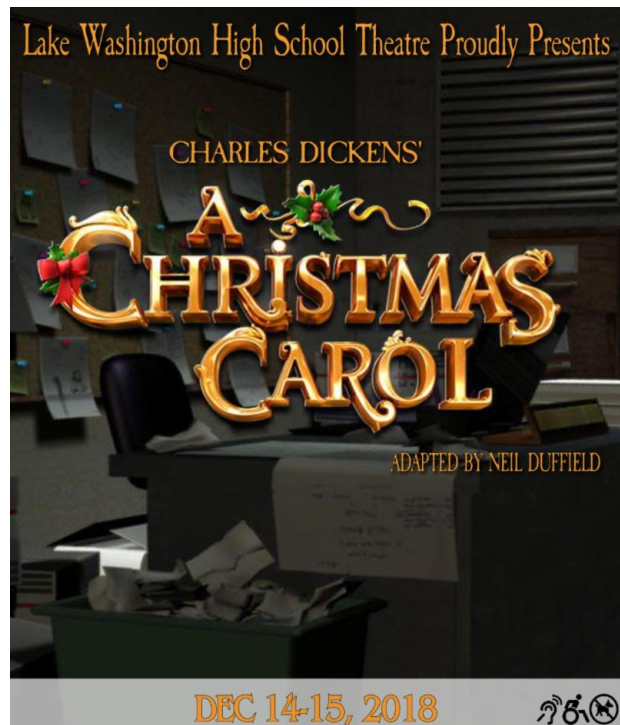

This registration certifies the eligibility of student athletes to participate in sports during their freshman year in college.
