1. Call to Order – 7:01 pm. The meeting was held via Zoom due to COVID 19.

### 2. Secretary

- a. Secretary Cheryl Geels shared the minutes from the January 27, 2021 General Membership meeting. The minutes were approved with edits and entered into record.
- b. There was no correspondence to report.

### 3. Treasurer Report

a. Treasurer Julie Tribolet shared the January/February 2021 treasurer report, and it was moved into record.

### 4. New Business

a. Budget Reallocation

- i. EVP Denise Ferguson made a motion that we move \$2500 from the "Students in Need/Invest Ed" line item to the "Grants - ASB & Enrichment" line item. The motion was seconded by VP Meredith O'Connor-Schwietzer. The motion passed with unanimous approval from the membership.
- *ii.* Chair Brandi Comstock made a motion to approve the budget, as revised. The motion was seconded by EVP Denise Ferguson seconded. The motion passed with unanimous approval from the membership. The revised budget includes the changes approved above and a small reallocation made by the board per our standing rules to cover the addition of media liability insurance.
- *b.* Mid-Year Financial Review: VP Meredith O'Connor-Schwietzer presented the findings of the mid-year financial review. There were no errors found in accounting or recommendations for changes. *The review was accepted as presented unanimously by the membership.*
