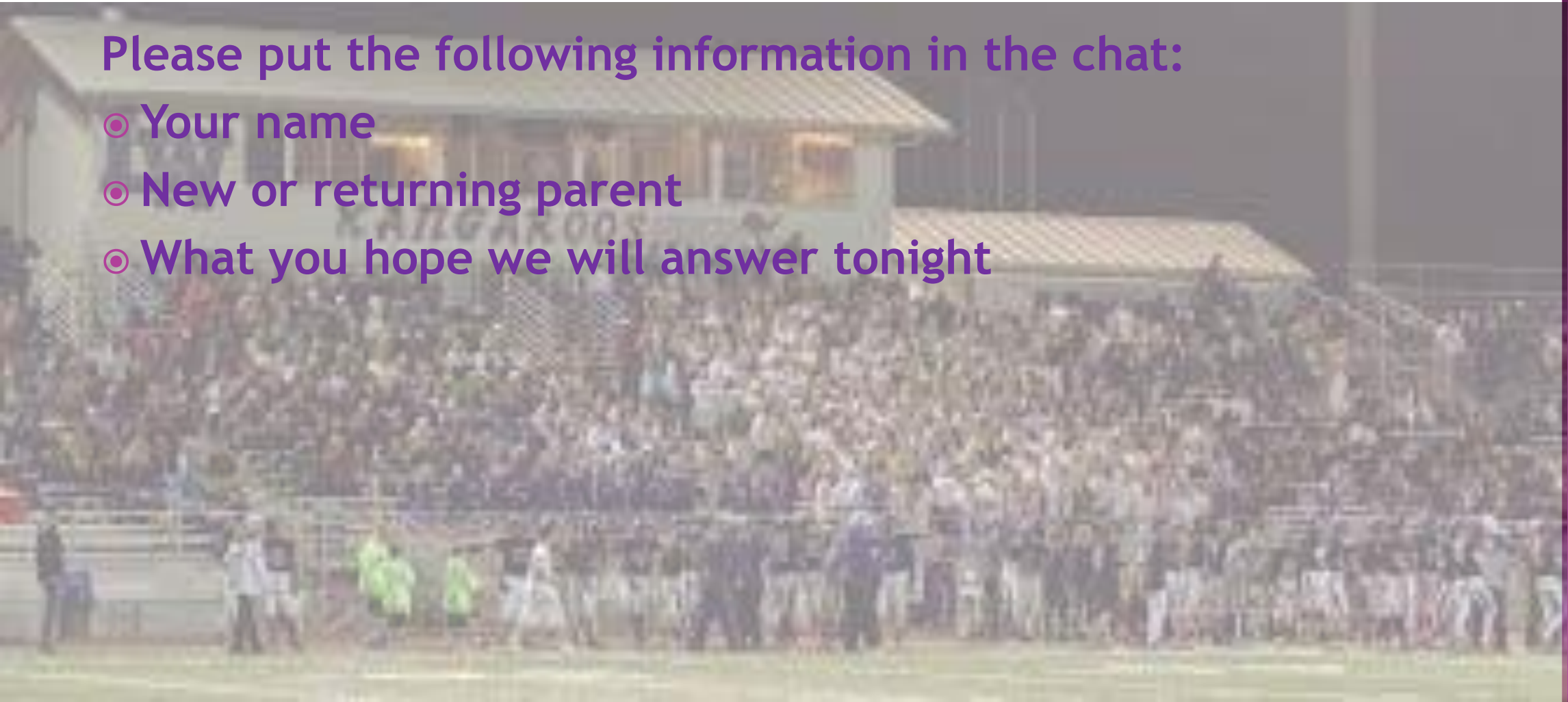

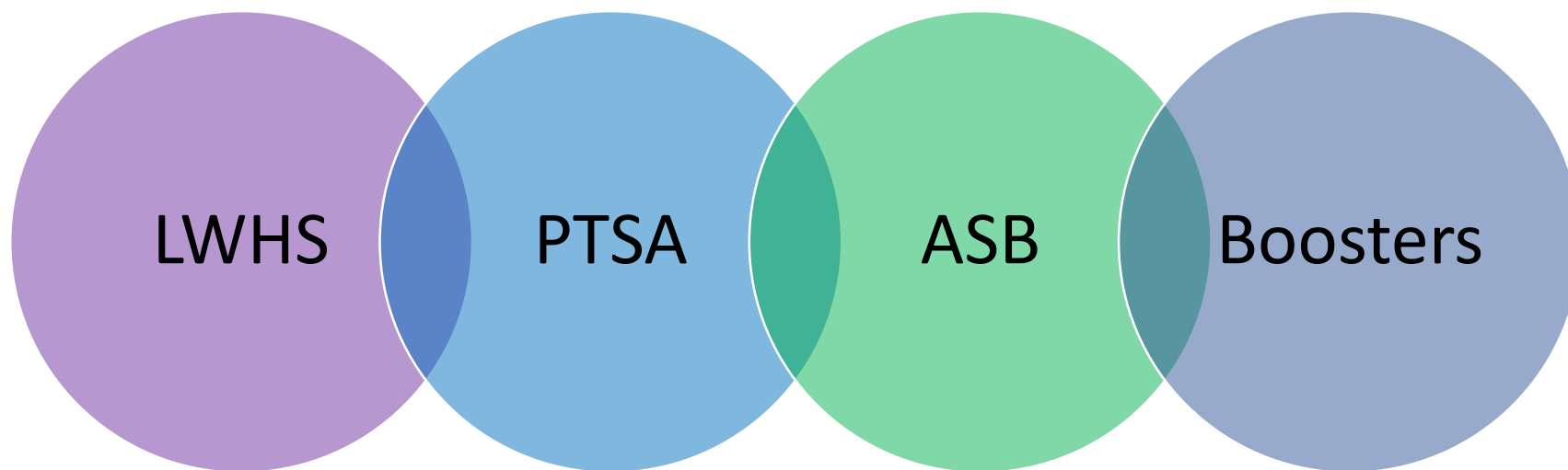

Who are they? Why do they all want money?

LAKE WASHINGTON HIGH SCHOOL (LWHS)

Part of LWSD which is governed by an elected school board and run by administrators in the district office. Some local control by administration team. Parent volunteers must pass a background check by the LWSD.

School volunteer activities:

- AVID Tutors
- Some classroom help
- Help with picture day
- Laptop roll out (often organized by PTSA)

Money collected for:

PE Uniforms, Class specific fees, Library fines, Parking Permits, Yearbooks, AP/SAT Test Fees, Field trip fees, Sports Fees, School Lunches (Sodexo)

ASSOCIATED STUDENT BODY (ASB)

Student group that represents the entire student body. Public funds generated by students may be used only for optional/non-credit cultural, athletic, social or recreational purposes. Governed by elected/appointed ASB student officers in close coordination with the Leadership teacher/ASB advisor.

Activities/Programs/Expenditures:

- Dances, Kangapalooza, poetry slam
- 30+ ASB approved student clubs
- Yearbook
- Honor Society
- Afterschool sports
- Drama, DECA, school newspaper

How Funds are Raised:

ASB Card & Membership fees for various clubs, Yearbook sales, Athletic fees, Student Store sales, Admission tix, Other (finals week care packages, holiday grams..)

PARENT TEACHER STUDENT ASSOCIATION (PTSA)

A non-profit national organization that enables parents to advocate for, volunteer in and connect more closely with their local school, district & state educational system. A non-profit run by parent volunteers. Governed by a board elected by members of the local PTSA organization.

Activities/Programs/Expenditures:

Grants that benefit curriculum/academic/social-emotional activities

LAKE WA HIGH SCHOOL BOOSTER CLUB

A non-profit organization of elected volunteer officers that support and elevate member athletic and arts booster clubs at LW. Sponsored by the Athletic Director and run by parent volunteers, the umbrella club has a board that processes matching funding, ensures guidelines are followed, and creates a forum for clubs to collaborate. Individual booster clubs do their own fundraising and spending.

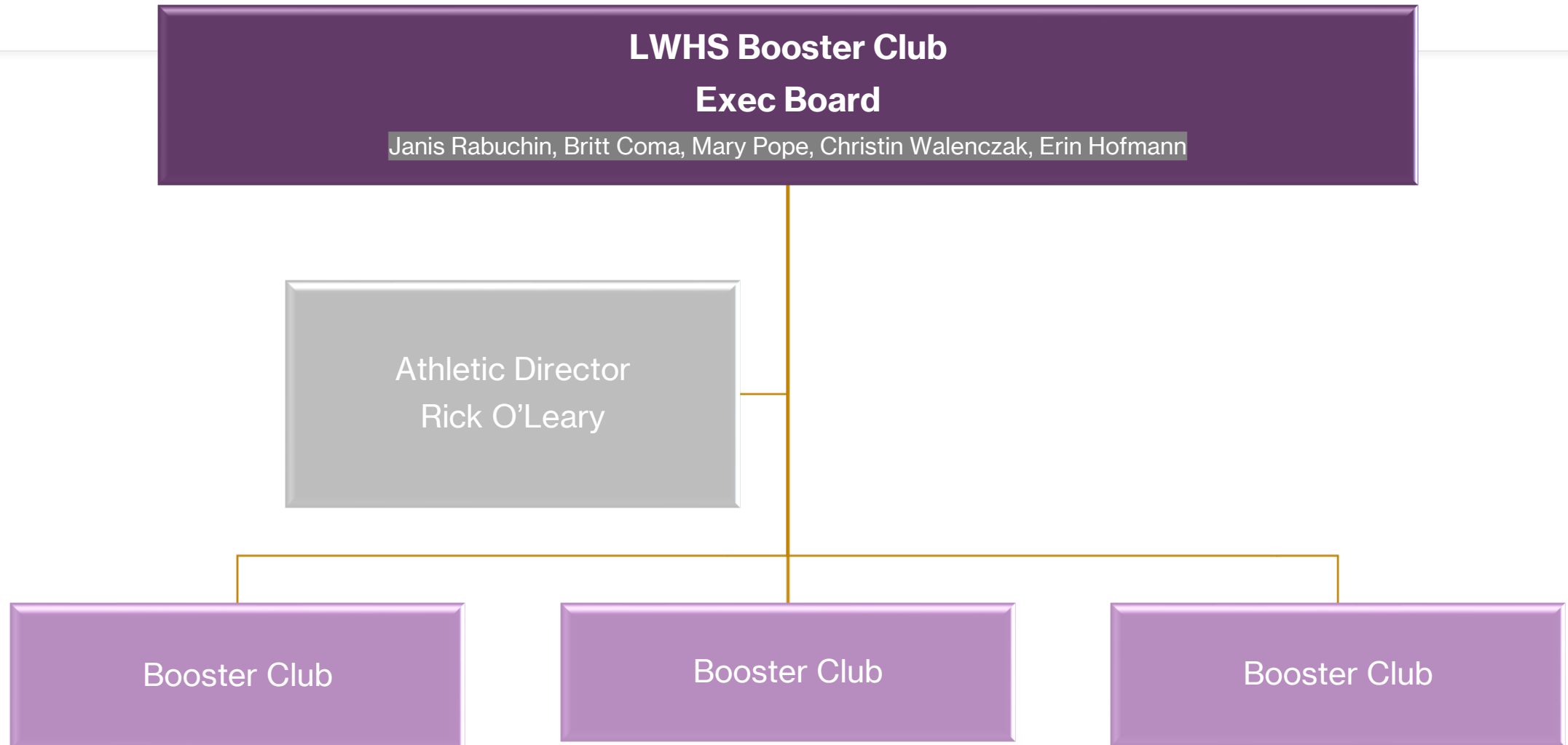
LWHS

Studies show that students who participate in co-curricular activities, versus those who do not, are more likely to:

- ◉ Have higher grade point averages
